

Scottish Centenary Badge

General Info

- 4 quarters - one for each theme of Heritage, Creativity, Community Action and Adventure
- Members can gain a badge through unit, District, Division, County or Scottish or UK activities
- Although each badge can stand alone, the four badges make up a larger design, which reflects the Saltire Flag to encourage members to participate in all four themes
- Some activities will cover more than one theme

Suggested activities for gaining the badges:

Creativity

- One World, One Beat
- Tartan Gig
- Participate in Gang Show, NSGSO, Fusion, other similar
- Attend Gang Show, NSGSO, Fusion, other similar
- Produce some sort of art work to commemorate the centenary e.g. collage, mosaic, tapestry, embroidery, photo...
- Produce a Centenary scrapbook
- Attend a local Thinking Day event
- Centenary campfire
- Photo pin board
- Catch the moment
- Etc.

Heritage

- Learn & dance the Centenary dance
- Participate in the story telling project
- Participate in, or attend, a centenary exhibition
- Learn the Guide promise in Gaelic (not for Gaidhlig speakers!)
- Ask your local Trefoil Guild to visit and run an activity from when they were Brownies/Guides
- Ask your local Archives ladies to tell you about Guiding in the past and show some old uniforms or badges
- Learn knots and make something with macramé
- Pin board
- Catch the moment
- One o'clock gun
- Etc.

Adventure

- Participate in one of the Centenary activities e.g. Munro challenge, Guide getaway; Brownie Takeover, Centenary camp, Princess Party...
- Participate in a county/division/district centenary adventure event
- Participate in a centenary adventure e.g. PGA, Nethybridge, trip to Disneyland, trip to an island...
- Participate in or learn a new sporting/adventurous activity e.g. skiing, tubing, archery, abseiling...
- Princess Party
- Etc.

Community

- Celebrate with flowers e.g. participate in the production of a Community garden
- Centenary garden display (Anything from miniature to large!)
- Improve a local area e.g. plant trees, daffodils etc, pick up litter, donate litter bins...
- Change the World activities!
- Adopt a charity and raise awareness or money for it
- Do a good turn for a local person/people/sheltered housing/school/church.
