

Our methodology

Girls in Scotland 2020 is a subset of data from the Girls' Attitudes Survey 2020. A total of 527 girls and young women in Scotland aged between 7 and 21 took part in the 2020 survey. Girlguiding commissioned CHILDWISE, leading specialists in research with children and young people, to conduct the survey.

Interviews were completed online, with data first collected in schools during March, and then via a large proprietary online panel - following the UK an Scottish governments closure of schools due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Interviews with young women who were not in education, employment, or training (NEET) were also included via the online panel, ensuring representation of this potentially marginalised group.

The questionnaire was adapted to be suitable for different age groups, 7 to 10 and 11 to 21 years. Core questions were asked across the full age range, so that changes in attitudes as girls get older can be tracked.

Fieldwork took place from March to April 2020.

Sample Details

Data was weighted at analysis to correct any imbalance in the final sample across the age range. All questions are based on those answering.




