# **Role description**

### 1.1 The purpose of the role

- Welcome and support volunteers who would like to become a prospective trainer.
- Assist our becoming a trainer volunteers to set up their roles visits and shadowing a training.
- Support and nurture our becoming a trainer volunteers.
- Check all paperwork is submitted and correct and liaise with staff to ensure references are completed.
- Work closely with our prospective trainer and tutor coordinator to ensure a smooth pipeline into the role of prospective trainer.

## 1.2 Skills and experience needed for the role

- Have good organisational skills.
- Be able to communicate with various volunteers and staff teams.
- Be able to work as part of a team.
- Experience of supporting people to complete qualifications. (desirable)

## 1.3 Induction, training, and support

- All volunteers are given an in-depth induction into their role.
- This role receives ongoing staff support from the volunteer experience project coordinator and volunteer line manager support from the lead volunteer for learning and development. Expenses for travel & subsistence may be claimed for any travel required to complete your role.

• This role is for 3 years.

## 1.4 As part of this role, you will need to:

- Attend 4 meetings of the learning and development team each year (3 are virtual with 1 face-to-face meeting).
- Hold check-ins with becoming a trainer volunteers.
- Attend Scottish training events
- Attend other ad hoc meetings that require your attendance, these will include meetings with anyone in the process and attendance at Scottish trainer events.
