We would like to buy uniform for 15 girls in our unit of 29 who don't have uniform currently. We'd offer these to parents as a loan so they could be the basis of a uniform bank in future. (We have lots of low income families in our area so uniform costs can be a barrier to joining.) We have also had a new unit helper join our unit recently and would like to subsidise their uniform too.

We would like to buy 15 short sleeve Brownie t-shirts (£10.50 each, totalling £157.50) and 1 navy leader polo shirt (£19.25).
